Bicyclist Overtaking (3-Foot Passing) Signs	Miller / Schultheiss	W	ACTIVE. Several states have developed signs in conjunction with 3-foot passing laws. As more states add laws, more impetus for an effective standard sign. Some controversy regarding sign message, non-standard symbols, unintended messages. Some guidance included in new ITE Traffic Control Devices Handbook. Florida State Univ study in 2013. Jan 2015: RWSTC identified as a priority topic. Results from FHWA TCD PFS should be available late spring 2017.
Signs and Markings for Bicycles at Rail / Light Rail Crossings	Cynecki	R	ACTIVE. RRLRTC proposal to sponsors fall 2010, but withdrawn pending revision. June 2015: RPS sent to FHWA for pooled fund study on bicyclist / tracks warning sign. PFS results should be available late spring 2017.
Definitions in Part 1	Schultheiss	E	ACTIVE. Terms are used in MUTCD, UVC, elsewhere. Different terms used by advocates. Start with definitions in new FHWA Separated BL Guide? Schultheiss to draft proposal for BTC & Edit Comm review.
Bicycle Repair Signing	Moeur / Jackson / Van Houten	G	ACTIVE. Need to evaluate new symbol signs for bicycle repair. Western Michigan Univ may perform experimental testing spring 2017(?).

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Change Lanes to Pass Plaque	Jackson / Moeur	W	ACTIVE. Original R4-11 concept in 2005 had "Change Lanes To Pass" plaque, but action tabled to focus on R4-11 approval. Agencies are using this plaque with R4-11s - national standardization might be beneficial. Proposal to be developed in BTC with RWSTC input.
Bikeways at T Intersections	Koonce	W,M,S	ACTIVE. Bicyclists on thru leg have few conflicts with other movements - looking at ways to accommodate. Conflicts with crossing pedestrians can be an issue. Koonce to draft RPS to analyze.
Community Wayfinding Signs and Bicyclists	Schultheiss	G	ACTIVE. Current MUTCD Section 2D.50 doesn't address wayfinding for bicyclists or on bikeways. Chapter 9B provides good info on bikeway guide sign design, but no details on wayfinding. Agencies are using a wide variety of designs and colors for bikeway wayfinding. Exact conformance to 9C isn't always seen, but as long as info is presented in legible & uniform manner, purpose is fulfilled. Changes to 2D.50 and/or Chapter 2B may be needed. Schultheiss to develop draft proposal.
Bicycle Parking Plaque	Petritsch / DeBruyn	G	ACTIVE. Outgrowth of Park and Ride sign issue. GMITC asked BTC to develop plaque for use under D4-2 signs to make travelers aware of bicycle parking.
Advance Placement of Bicycle Warning Signs	Moeur	W	ACTIVE. Warning signs generally use Table 2C-4 for advance placement, but no counterpart for warning signs intended for bicyclists. Also no uniform criteria for assigning signs as bike-only vs for other vehicles. Concerns re 2C-4 advance placement distance vs urban conditions. Limited design guidance. Proposal to be developed in BTC w/RWSTC input.
Connected / Automated Vehicles and Bicycle Traffic Control	Carlson / Dingess / Bagdade	Research	Fall 2016: NCUTCD Research Committee identified CV/AV as critical issue of TCD / MUTCD impact. Jan 2017: BTC provided list of bicycle-related issues to be considered by task force. Awaiting joint TF action.

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Revisions to Uniform Vehicle Code Chapter 11 (Rules of the Road)	Allen	E	ACTIVE. NCUTLO owned and developed UVC, but became inactive in 2002 (after publishing 2000 UVC). UVC "orphaned" after this date. Other transportation, legal, enforcement orgs contacted re maintaining the UVC - no interest. NCUTCD agreed to update Chap 11 (Rules of Road) - other UVC chapters still "orphaned". Revisions to bicycle sections assigned to BTC. Preliminary revisions drafted in 2012 - comments received 2013. Topic was placed on hold 2013-2014 to focus on proposed content for next MUTCD - reactivated fall 2014. Use of e-mail list to develop UVC content not as effective as anticipated.
Technical Guidance on Shared Lane Markings (Phase 2)	DeSantis	M	PENDING Detailed technical guidance in ITE Traffic Control Devices Handbook. Dec 2013: FHWA added material in Part 9 draft. Proposal drafted by BTC in mid-2016 but SLM figures removed due to sponsor feedback and status of pending research. BTC still sees need for added figures - will develop based on research results (such as green bkgd on SLM experiments) and added input.
ON ROAD Plaque (Replacing "Share The Road")	Schultheiss	W	PENDING. Numerous reported concerns and misinterpretations of "Share The Road" plaques; however, there is a large installed base of these sign assemblies. Some jurisdictions (Delaware, others) have discontinued W16-1P use. Intent is to "retire" W16-1P and replace with new "ON ROAD" plaque for same application. Use "ON ROAD" in lieu of "IN LANE" or "ON SHOULDER" for greater scope of application and to not send unintended messages. Draft proposal from Schultheiss April 2016. Rejected by RWSTC June 2016 on basis that proposed legend has not been evaluated. Research problem statement pending. TCD Pooled Fund Study did NOT approve for testing FY 2017.
Sidepath Intersection Conflicts	Allen, Van Houten, Fox	M, S, W	PENDING. Some research on active devices at path/roadway intersections. June 2015: Identified as research need - Miller drafting RPS for Research Committee. Michigan DOT research on differential criteria (path vs. lane, speed/intersections/etc.) for sidepaths.

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Markings for Bicycle Guidance	Curtis / Engelhart	M	PENDING. Experimental results from Columbia MO presented at June 2016 meeting. Develop figures & guidelines in future?
Bicycle Signal Lane Control Signs	DeSantis	W, S	PENDING. Originated out of 2015 TCD Pooled Fund Study (initiated by FHWA). PFS report reviewed at June 2016 meeting. Concerns identified by BTC and STC. Draft joint research problem statement from BTC & STC pending.
Colored Bike Lanes		M	PENDING. FHWA issued Interim Approval April 2011. Markings TC is taking lead on all pavement colors - BTC will be consulted on green. Draft FHWA content on colored pavement issued Dec 2013 - MTC is reviewing with BTC input. June 2014: no consensus on scope of use of green - will let current FHWA Interim Approval address until rulemaking. Awaiting NPA content. June 2015: ATSSA task force may recommend changes to marking color box. Experimentation underway on color under other markings (shared lane marking, etc.)
Bike Lane Marking at Intersection Approaches	Petritsch	M	ON INDEFINITE HOLD. Important for MUTCD & other references. 3 different treatments (solid, dotted, dropped) - which one is best? Little actual data - just preference / practice. Research proposal included in FY 2013 SCOR ballot, but not funded. Unclear if NCHRP 15-63 will address.
Bike Lanes at Back-in Angle Parking	Kingsbury	M, W	ON INDEFINITE HOLD. Preliminary recommendations in ITE Traffic Control Devices Handbook. Dec 2013: Placeholder in Part 9 draft - FHWA requested content from BTC. Insufficient data to justify or develop MUTCD content. Awaiting NPA content - expect to be addressed in design guides.
Bike / Bus / RT lanes	DeRobertis	M, W	ON INDEFINITE HOLD. Used in several localities. Info available on Allen's site (bikexpert.com). Need to collect current research / data and develop proposal. June 2014: red color pavement bus lane proposal approved by NCUTCD. Awaiting NPA content.

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Revised Bicycle Symbol	Moeur	W, M	ON INDEFINITE HOLD. Requested by outside "working group" led by Meeker. Proposal to use just one symbol for all bicycle signs, markings, and other devices. Research results submitted - questions as to whether there is compelling justification for change. Will need discussion and concurrence from Markings & RWSTC (no action yet). Also interest in an end-on bicycle symbol, but no action yet.

Interim Approval IA-18 (Advance Stop Line) and Signal Requirements	Suter, DeSantis	S	COMPLETE. IA-18 on "bike boxes" issued fall 2016. NCUTCD content silent on signals, but IA requires countdown signals at multi-lane BBs. Signals TC concerned re signal operations impact of IA. Joint BTC/STC task force developed proposed IA-18 revisions. Approved by NCUTCD Council January 2017.
